3. Students will then enter the activity. (example pictured is a student-paced quiz question)

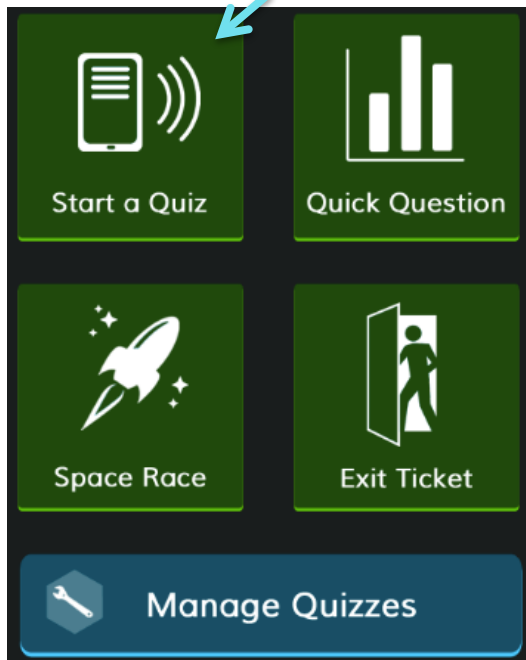

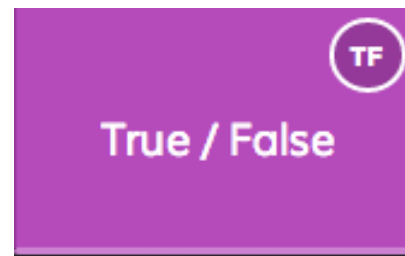
